PROTECTION. Head-protector (with top head cover), gloves (10 oz), shin guards no sock's type (according to the new rules), groin protection (breast protection for female fighters) according to WAKO-rules fighters bring by themselves. Another protection according to WAKO-rules. The symbols of MUAYTHAI is forbidden!!!

STARTING FEE

Starting fee for Ring and Tatami Sports

25 EUR per competitor.

For Estonian Kickboxing Federation fee 20 EUR. starting is Payment during the registration in cash.

ACCOMMODATION Organizer is responsible for accommodation of the referees, but only for **personally** appointed by organizing committee.

Every team have to take care of accommodation by themselves

VISA.

All participants must take visas in Estonian embassies in their countries **if needed.**

MEDICAL SERVICES

Organizer is responsible for medical help to all official members of participating teams during the competition (according to their health-insurance).

MEDALS AND AWARDING.

All first three places winners will have medals and diplomas.

ENTRY-FORMS

Preliminary entry-forms have to be send no later than February. 06. 2020 by email: wakoest@gmail.com

Extra fee (5 EUR for each participant) will be charged for every application, enquired after 06.02.2020 deadline.

Preliminary entry-forms are needed to know the exact quantity of medals. If the entry-form will be present later than 06th of February 2020, the participant risks not to get a diploma and medal.

NB! Every club have to fill, print out and present to the registration "Competitor's file" (page number 4 of current invitation). If clubs do not present filled "Competitor's file" to the registration desk, clubs have to buy "Competitor's file" which costs 1 euro per sportsmen.

WEIGHTING-IN

Registration and weighting-in of the fighters will be made after presenting the following documents:

- 1) WAKO sport pass for WAKO members.
- National pass or ID card (no more driving license according to the new WAKO rules)
- 3) Valid permit to fight signed by sport doctor. If sportsmen do not have a medical permit, commission on registration desk could make extra ordinary decision regards addition medical check and establish additional penalties.
- Insurance
- 5) All participants must take visas by them self in Estonian embassies in their countries if needed.
- 6) Money in cash for starting fee.
